

The life of Peter Donders

- 1809 Born on the 27th of October as son to a home-weaver
- 1831 Pupil and servant at the seminary in St. Michielsgestel
- 1837 Start of study as seminarian at St. Michielsgestel
- 1841 Ordained priest at Oegstgeest
- 1842 Left for Surinam; was curate in Paramaribo until 1855
- 1855 Pastor in the leper colony, Batavia
- 1867 Joined the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (Redemptorists); missionary work among the Indians and negroes living in the jungle
- 1883 Pastoral work in Paramaribo and Coronie
- 1885 Return to leper colony, Batavia
- 1887 Died from a kidney infection on the 14th of January
- 1900 Mortal remains transferred to Paramaribo
- 1982 Beatified on the 23rd of May
- 2010 Reinterned in the current tomb in Paramaribo
